The State of Michigan requires that chiropractors wishing to renew their license complete 30 hours of continuing education during their two-year licensure period. Included in this requirement are:

Ethics and Boundaries

Ethics and Boundaries credits are not available at the Express Convention. If you still need ethics and boundaries credits in your current license period, they are available online at https://chiromi.ce21.com/item/2023-express-convention in "related products." Rates for the Ethics and Sexual Boundaries webinar are above and beyond convention rates because doctors who attend all 15 hours of the Express Convention and then attend the Ethics and Boundaries webinar will receive a total of 17 credit hours. If you only need a total of 15 hours from the Express Convention, and you have already achieved the 15 live hours needed for license renewal, contact the MAC at (517) 367-2225 or info@chiromi.com to make arrangements.

Implicit Bias Training – 2 hours

Implicit Bias Training hours can now be included within the 30 hours of continuing education needed for license renewal. This is a significant change, so be aware of how your current hours could be affected.

Implicit Bias Training and Human Trafficking Requirement

<u>Implicit Bias Training</u>: In 2023, the State of Michigan rescinded the administrative rule requiring Implicit Bias Training to be obtained only through in-person or programs that permit "live synchronous interaction." In other words, online "on-demand" programs are now acceptable.

Chiropractors are required to obtain two hours of Implicit Bias Training every license cycle. **This training can now be included <u>within the 30 hours of continuing education needed for license renewal</u> (or the hours needed for relicensure). The MAC has one- and two-hour webinars that satisfy the State of Michigan's requirement. Click the QR code at right to access this webinar.**

Human Trafficking Requirement: Under Michigan law, health care providers licensed or registered under Michigan's public health code, including chiropractors, are required to undergo a *one-time* training in identifying victims of human trafficking as a condition of license renewal or initial licensure. To ensure compliance, the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) may select and audit a sample of individuals and request documentation of proof of completion of training. Failure to provide acceptable proof of completion of training could lead to possible sanctions against your license.

Many of you have already completed this training. If you have not, we urge you to do so as soon as possible. If you are not sure whether you have completed it, go to the MAC booth or contact the MAC at (517) 367-2225 or info@chiromi.com.

<u>Keep in Mind</u>: The Human Trafficking requirement is not that a licensee gain an hour of continuing education in identifying the victims of human trafficking, like the mandated categories of ethics, sexual boundaries, or pain and symptom management, or the mandated number of hours required for Implicit Bias Training. There is no specific number of hours needed, just a requirement that training is completed. Be wary of outside vendors claiming that an hour of continuing education is required.
